Reporting to the CEO, the Licensing Librarian is responsible for identifying, investigating, recommending, negotiating, implementing and administering consortial licensing initiatives. The position liaises with information providers on access and technical issues and coordinates training among license participants. The Licensing Librarian works closely with TAL's Licensing Service Committee, providing members with support and leadership. Qualifications

A Masters degree in Library Science from a recognized post-secondary institution is essential and a minimum of two years of relevant work experience is required. Experience in a consortium environment is an asset. Equivalencies will be considered.
