Clive Maishment appointed CEO of The Alberta Library

June 17, 2010 ... The Alberta Library, a province-wide consortium that serves over 300 member libraries across the province, has appointed Clive Maishment as CEO, effective June 21, 2010.

The appointment is a one-year secondment from his position as Edmonton Public Library's Director of Library Services. Maishment has also served as Executive Director of Yellowhead Regional Library.

Maishment's experience with The Alberta Library includes serving on the Board of Directors from 1997 to 2008, and on the Executive Committee from 2001 to 2007. He also served on the Alberta Public Library Electronic Network Standing Committee from 1999 to 2007, and chaired the committee for five years.

"Clive's extensive experience with The Alberta Library, complemented by his depth of knowledge of the provincial library community, will serve the organization well over the next year as we work together to build on our tradition of cooperation, collaboration and innovation," said TAL Board Chair Maggie Macdonald.
