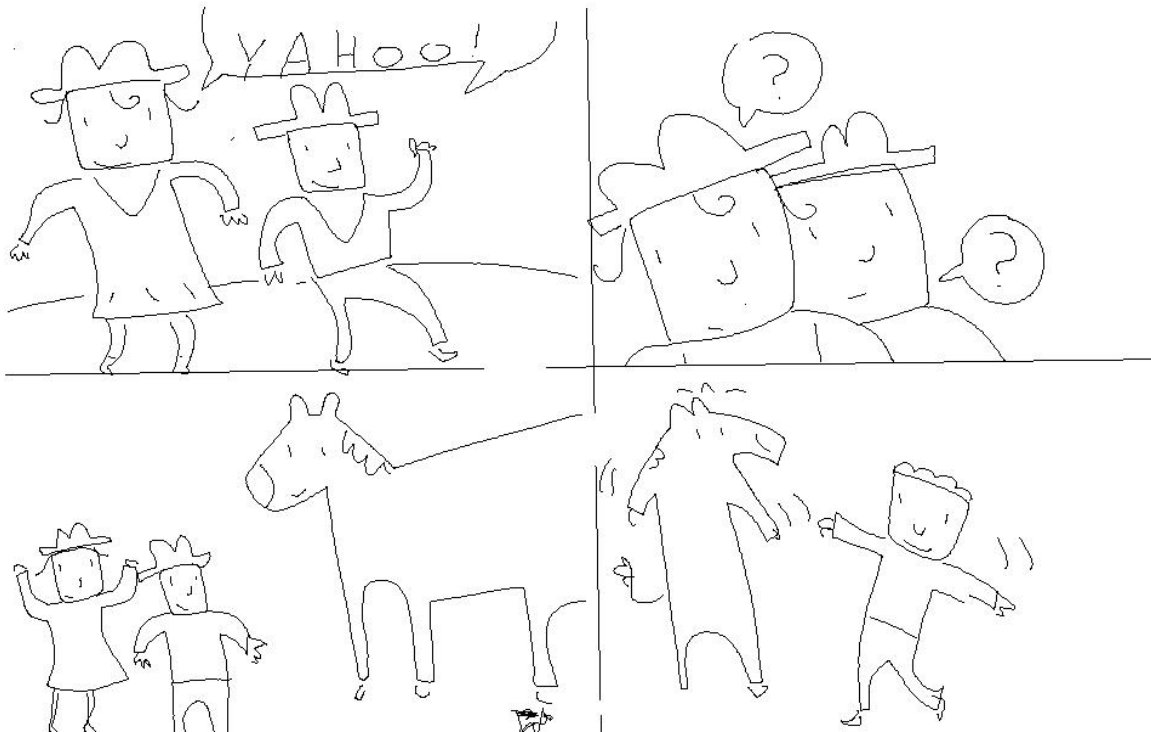


The Alberta Library – July 14, 2004

They got tired and went home, but went back to the Stampede the next day, ready to do more things.



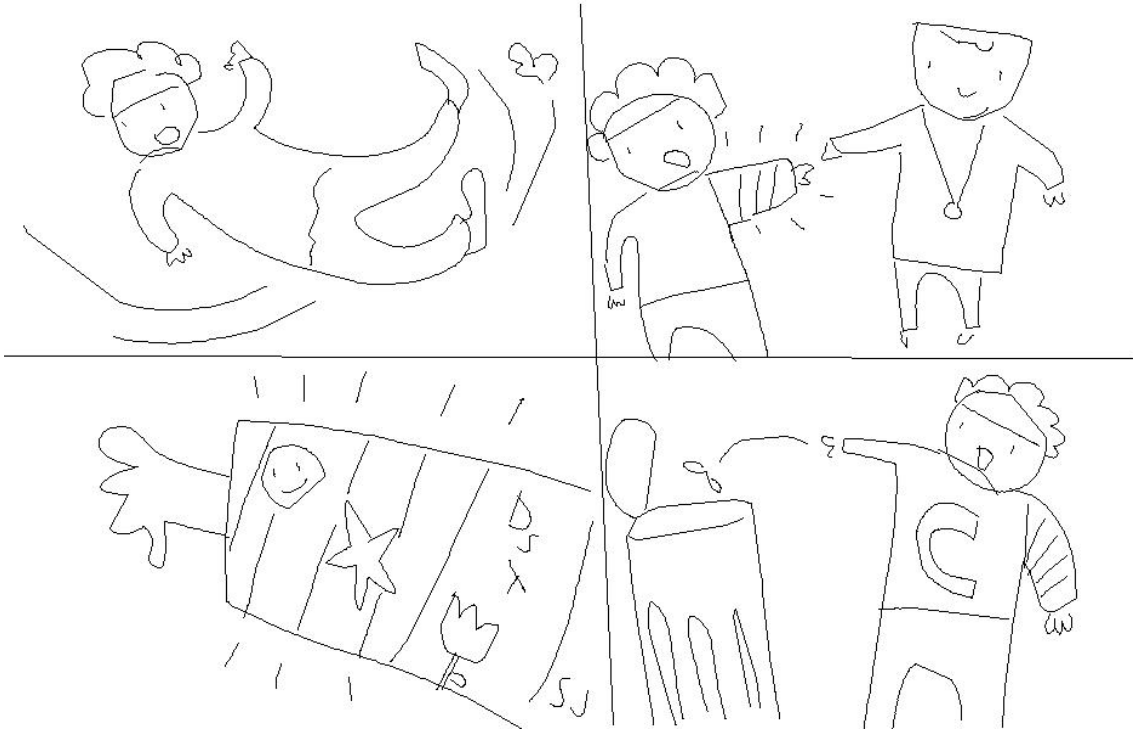
They rode horses and went on rides.
